SYNOPSES OF UPCOMING FILMS

AN AMERICAN TAIL (1986-G) 1hr. 20 min. Animation/Kids. "It is not only beautifully rendered, it also boasts a well-told story, full of interesting characters and situations." Fievel is a young Russian mouse separated from his parents on the way to America, a land they think is without cats. When he arrives alone in the New World, he keeps up hope, searching for his family, making new friends, and running and dodging the cats he thought he'd be rid of.

BREATHLESS (1960-NR) 1 hr. 30 min. Crime/Drama. "Breathless seems to me the most original, insolently gifted and shattering work the young French directors have, yet produced." A small-time crook, hunted by the authorities for a car theft and the murder of a police officer, attempts to persuade a hip American journalism student to run away with him to Italy. DAFFY DUCK'S FANTASTIC ISLAND (1983-G) 1 hr. 18 min. Animation/Family. "This is just plain fun! Nice collage of classic Warner cartoons with a Fantasy Island premise." Daffy Duck and Speedy Gonzales find a treasure map that leads them to a wishing well, which for a penny will grant any wish (through old cartoon footage). Daffy sets up a resort around the well and various Looney Tunes characters have their dreams come true. Meanwhile, Yosemite Sam and the Tasmanian Devil hunt for the varmints who stole their treasure map!

DC LEAGUE OF SUPER-PETS (2022-PG) 1hr. 45 min. Animation/kids. "A delightful look at the superhero genre that introduces a furry team of unlikely heroes to the ever-growing heroic world." When the Justice League are captured by Lex Luthor, Superman's dog, Krypto, forms a team of shelter-pets who were given super-powers: A hound named Ace, who becomes super-strong, a pig named PB, who can grow to giant-size, a turtle named Merton, who becomes super-fast, and a squirrel named Chip, who gains electric-powers.

EASY A (2010-PG-13) 1 hr. 32 min. Comedy/Romance. "Easy A is a timeless teen classic worth its weight of scarlet letters stretched across your chest." After a little white lie about losing her virginity gets out, a clean-cut high school girl sees her life paralleling Hester Prynne's in "The Scarlet Letter," which she is currently studying in school - until she decides to use the rumor mill to advance her social and financial standing.

E.T. (1982-PG) 1 hr. 55 min. Family. "E.T. The Extra-Terrestrial is a spellbinding foray that reminds us of human compassion and the eternal joy of cinema." After a gentle alien becomes stranded on Earth, he is discovered and befriended by a 10-year-old boy named Elliott. Bringing him into his suburban California house, Elliott introduces E.T., as he is dubbed, to his brother,

Michael, and sister, Gertie, and they decide to keep his existence a secret. Soon, however, he falls ill, resulting in government intervention and a dire situation for both him and Elliott.

EVIL DOES NOT EXIST (2023) 1 hr. 46 min. Drama. "This is an instant-masterpiece worthy of intense debate in which every side will have a valid point." Takumi and his daughter Hana live in Mizubiki Village, close to Tokyo. One day, the village inhabitants become aware of a plan to build a camping site near Takumi's house, offering residents a comfortable escape to nature. Japanese with English subtitles.

EZRA (2023-R) 1 hr. 41 min. Comedy/Drama. "Ezra gives a nuanced, realistic, and heartrending look at a boy with autism and his family, which tells the truths that Rain Man glossed over." Comedian Max co-parents autistic son Ezra with ex-wife Jenna. Faced with crucial decisions about Ezra's future, Max and Ezra go on a life-changing cross-country road trip.

THE FALL GUY (2024-PG-13) 2 hrs. 6 min. Action/Romance/Comedy/Drama. "Cleverly written, wickedly funny, wildly entertaining." He's a stuntman, and like everyone in the stunt community, he gets blown up, shot, crashed, thrown through windows and dropped from the highest of heights, all for our entertainment. And now, fresh off an almost career-ending accident, this working-class hero has to track down a missing movie star, solve a conspiracy and try to win back the love of his life while still doing his day job. What could possibly go right?

FURIOSA: A MAD MAX SAGA (2024-R) 2 hrs. 28 min. Action/Sci-Fi. "It is a saga. It is an epic. It is enthralling." As the world fell, young Furiosa is snatched from the Green Place of Many Mothers and falls into the hands of a great Biker Horde led by the Warlord Dementus. Sweeping through the Wasteland they come across the Citadel presided over by The Immortan Joe. While the two Tyrants war for dominance, Furiosa must survive many trials as she puts together the means to find her way home.

THE GREAT MUPPET CAPER (1981-G) 1 hr. 37 min. Comedy/Family. "I am always amazed at how the Muppets blend into the human world. Never has this been better done." Kermit the Frog, The Great Gonzo, and Fozzie Bear are reporters who travel to Britain to interview the rich victim of jewel thieves and help her along with her secretary, Miss Piggy.

GUARDIANS OF THE GALAXY (2014-PG-13) 2hrs. 1 min. Action/Comedy/Sci-Fi. "A cheerful blockbuster in which Star Wars meets Ziggy Stardust." After stealing a mysterious orb in the far reaches of outer space, Peter Quill from Earth is now the main target of a manhunt led by the villain known as Ronan the Accuser. To help fight Ronan and his team and save the galaxy from his power, Quill creates a team of space heroes known as the "Guardians of the Galaxy" to save the galaxy.

INDIANA JONES & THE LAST CRUSADE (1989-PG-13) 2 hrs. 7 min. Action. "The Last Crusade may well become the sentimental favorite, the Indiana to end them all." In 1938, after his father goes missing while pursuing the Holy Grail, Indiana Jones finds himself up against the Nazis again to stop them from obtaining its powers.

JAWS (1975-PG) 2 hrs. 4 min. Thriller. "The pinnacle of shark movies, one of the greatest films ever made." When a killer shark unleashes chaos on a beach community off Cape Cod, it's up to a local sheriff, a marine biologist, and an odd seafarer to hunt the beast down.

MINIONS: THE RISE OF GRU (2022-PG) 1 hr. 27 min. Animation/Family. "The minions are brilliant animated slapstick and there's something about it that just tickles my funny bone." The untold story of one twelve-year-old's dream to become the world's greatest supervillain.

MR. & MRS. SMITH (1941) 1hr. 35 min. Comedy/Romance. "Lombard and Montgomery are teamed successfully here in a light and gay marital farce." A couple who has been married for three years are shocked to learn that their marriage is not legally valid.

THE MUPPET MOVIE (1979-G) 1 hr. 35 min. Comedy/Family. "The Muppet Movie changed cinema forever and much like "Rainbow Connection," the iconic classic remains fun for the whole family." Kermit and his newfound friends trek across America to find success in Hollywood, but a frog legs merchant is after Kermit. 45th ANNIVERSARY SCREENING!

THE PIRATES! BAND OF MISFITS (2012-PG) 1 he. 28 min. Animation/Family. "The result is a hurrah for the return of Aardman's finest. Easily their most enjoyable film since Wallace & Gromit." Pirate captain sets out on a mission to defeat his rival Black Bellamy and Cutlass Liz for the Pirate of the Year Award. The quest takes Captain and his crew from the shores of Blood Island to the foggy streets of Victorian London.

SCOOB! (2020-PG) 1 hr. 33 min. Animation/Family. "Scooby & Shaggy's friendship as the main focus of the film is incredible and brings moments of relatability. Ultimately, Scoob! is one I'd recommend for anyone to watch." Scooby-Doo is the hero of his own story in "SCOOB!" the first full-length animated Scooby-Doo adventure, which reveals how he and his best friend Shaggy became two of the world's most beloved crime busters. The story takes us back to where it all began when a young Scooby and Shaggy first meet and team up with Velma, Daphne, and Fred to launch Mystery Incorporated.

SPELLBOUND (1945) 1 hr. 51 min. Mystery/Romance. "A twisty thriller in the best Hitchcockian tradition." Dr. Constance Petersen (Ingrid Bergman) is a psychiatrist at Green Manors mental asylum. The head of Green Manors has just been replaced, with his

replacement being the renowned Dr. Anthony Edwardes (Gregory Peck). Romance blossoms between Dr. Petersen and Dr. Edwardes, but Dr. Edwardes starts to show odd aversions and personality traits.

STAGE FRIGHT (1950) 1 hr. 50 min. Mystery/Thriller. "It's an entertaining film that deserves to become a cult favorite hit." A struggling actress tries to help a friend prove his innocence after he's accused of murdering the husband of a high-society entertainer.

SUSPICION (1941) 1 hr. 39 min. Mystery/Thriller. "A magnificent triumph in terms of direction and acting." A shy young heiress marries a charming gentleman, and soon begins to suspect he is planning to murder her.

THE TERMINATOR (1984-R) 1 hr. 47 min. Action/Sci-Fi. "It's a powerhouse sci-fi action adventure which is undeniably the most thrill-packed movie-going experience for ages." A human soldier is sent from 2029 to 1984 to stop an almost indestructible cyborg killing machine, sent from the same year, which has been programmed to execute a young woman whose unborn son is the key to humanity's future salvation.

TOP GUN (1986-PG) 1 hr. 49 min. Action/Drama. "Top Gun is a star-studded and visually stimulating sensation that succeeds splendidly as a big-screen spectacle." US Navy Lieutenant Pete Mitchell, call sign Maverick--an impetuous, daredevil pilot ace--is accepted into Top Gun, Miramar's elite Fighter School. But there, the impulsive young pilot will have to compete with the best of the best, including Iceman, a brilliant and highly competitive fellow student. Now, Mitchell must give his all; however, his father's mysterious and untimely demise still haunts him. Can Maverick prove his worth to Charlie, the flying school's no-nonsense astrophysics instructor? Will he be able to suppress his wild nature to win the prestigious Top Gun Trophy?

TOP GUN: MAVERICK (2022-PG-13) 2 hrs. 10 min. Action/Drama. "Maverick dished out generous amounts of bromance, action, and a truly-immersive narrative in swashbuckling style." Set 30 years after its predecessor, it follows Maverick's return to the United States Navy Strike Fighter Tactics Instructor program (also known as U.S. Navy-Fighter Weapons School - "TOPGUN"), where he must confront his past as he trains a group of younger pilots, among them the son of Maverick's deceased best friend Lieutenant Nick "Goose" Bradshaw, USN.

YANKEE DOODLE DANDY (1942) 2 hrs. 6 min. Drama/Family. "Yankee Doodle Dandy harks back to the golden days of cinema and is exceptional even among Hollywood's greatest musicals." A musical portrait of composer/singer/dancer George M. Cohan. From his early days as a child-star in his family's vaudeville show up to the time of his comeback at which he received a medal from the president for his special contributions to the US, this is the life- story of George M. Cohan, who produced, directed, wrote and starred in his own musical shows for which he composed his famous songs.


