CAMPUS THEATRE'S MID-DAY MATINEES – The Campus Theatre is excited to add a new screening option to our weekly line-up, with our Wednesday Mid-Day Matinees! Join us on Wednesday afternoons at 1:00 PM for a screening of our feature film of the week. Our Mid-Day Matinee tickets are \$7 for everyone. Our box office opens at 12:30 PM, movie passes will be accepted and membership benefits do apply!

NATIONAL THEATRE LIVE (NT LIVE) productions are screened in more than 2000 venues worldwide. Cameras are brought to the theatre one evening, and that live performance is seen, via satellite. U.S. theatres generally delay the broadcasts until the evening, or show the production on different days. These are the original live satellite feeds; no editing takes place between the time of transmission and showing. <u>Movie passes are not accepted for these presentations. Doors open at 12:30. Admission: Adults, \$15; Seniors, \$12; Students \$10</u>

+ Sunday, September 8 at 1:00 pm – SACRED ALASKA, Sacred Alaska is an award-winning documentary that offers an intimate look into Native Alaskan culture and spirituality. It showcases the profound influence of Orthodoxy, introduced by Russian monks in the late 18th century, on Alaskan society. The film highlights the unique way Alaskans have woven their indigenous beliefs with Orthodox traditions, deeply influencing their worldview. Kinney chronicled the entire trip via video and photos and have developed a special film to recap the adventure and what was learned along the way. After the film screening, Kinney will join several river-related experts for a panel discussion about the experience, the history of the Susquehanna River and its inhabitants, and some of the specific issues that the West Branch and its tributaries face. SYNOPSES OF UPCOMING FILMS

THE FABULOUS FOUR (2024– R) 1 hr. 38 min. Comedy. "A hoot, easy, funny script, the energy and familiarity of the four stars, lets us spend time with stars that we've known all our lives." The Fabulous Four tells the story of two friends who travel to be bridesmaids in a surprise wedding of their college girlfriend.

FLY ME TO THE MOON (2024–PG-13) 2 hrs. 12 min. Romantic Comedy. "*The motion picture world and romantic comedies needed a movie like this. Fly Me to the Moon takes romance into an entertaining orbit accented with a nice touch of nostalgia.*" Marketing maven Kelly Jones wreaks havoc on launch director Cole Davis's already difficult task. When the White House deems the mission too important to fail, the countdown truly begins.

HARRY POTTER & THE HALF-BLOOD PRINCE (2009- PG-13) 2 hrs. 33 min. Fantasy/Action. "With real chemistry between the characters, laugh-out-loud scenes of teen wizard angst, and some truly spectacular cinematography, it may even be the best in the series." As Harry Potter begins his sixth year at Hogwarts, he discovers an old book marked as "the property of the Half-Blood Prince" and begins to learn more about Lord Voldemort's dark past.

IT ENDS WITH US (2024-PG-13) 2hrs. 10 min. Romance/Drama. "Justin Baldoni directs a strong adaptation of the source material, being sensitive to the touchy subject matter and including full circle layers that add more meaning to moments in the film." When awoman's first love suddenly reenters her life, her relationship with a charming, but abusive neurosurgeon is upended and she realizes she must learn to rely on her own strength to make an impossible choice for her future.

NATIONAL THEATRE LIVE: NYE (2024-NR) 2 hrs. 40 min. Comedy/Drama. "Michael Sheen is perfect in this surefire hit; a mighty, moving piece of theatre." Confronted with death, Aneurin 'Nye' Bevan's deepest memories lead him on a mind-bending journey back through his life; from childhood to mining underground, Parliament and fights with Churchill.

TWISTER (1996-PG-13) 1 hr. 53 min. Action/Adventure. *"A true marvel of '90s movie magic that still holds up nearly 30 years later."* Two storm chasers on the brink of divorce must work together to create an advanced weather alert system by putting themselves in the cross-hairs of extremely violent tornadoes.

TWISTERS (2024 – PG-13) 2 hrs. 2 min. Action/Adventure. "*Twisters recaptures the excitement and wonder of the original through plenty of heart, making it a worthy successor and one of the best films of the summer.*" Kate Cooper, a retired tornado-chaser and meteorologist, is persuaded to return to Oklahoma to work with a new team and new technologies.

THE WEDDING SINGER (1998-PG-13) 1 hr. 37 min. Romance/Comedy. *"The chemistry between Sandler and Barrymore is something special to see here, and I think The Wedding Singer ends up being Sandler's best movie."* Robbie, a singer, and Julia, a waitress, are both engaged, but to the wrong people. Fortune intervenes to help them discover each other.
