SYNOPSIS OF UPCOMING FILMS

ANORA (2024 – R) 2 hrs. 19 min. Romantic Comedy. Anora, a young sex worker from Brooklyn, meets and impulsively marries the son of an oligarch. Once the news reaches Russia, her fairytale is threatened as his parents set out for New York to get the marriage annulled.

DUCK SOUP (1933 -NR) 1 hr. 9 min. Comedy. Rufus T. Firefly is named the dictator of bankrupt Freedonia and declares war on neighboring Sylvania over the love of his wealthy backer Mrs. Teasdale, contending with two inept spies who can't seem to keep straight which side they're on.

FANCY PANTS (1950 – NR) 1 hr. 32 min. Comedy. An American actor impersonating an English butler is hired by a woman from New Mexico to refine her husband and headstrong daughter. The complications increase when the town believes Arthur to be an Earl, and President Roosevelt decides to pay a visit.

FLOW (2024 – PG) 1 hr. 215 min. Animation/Family. Cat is a solitary animal, but as its home is devastated by a great flood, he finds refuge on a boat populated by various species, and will have to team up with them despite their differences.

FROZEN (2013 – PG) 1 hr. 42 min. Animation/Family. Fearless optimist Anna teams up with rugged mountain man Kristoff and his loyal reindeer Sven in an epic journey to find Anna's sister Elsa, whose icy powers have trapped the kingdom of Arendelle in eternal winter.

MERCHANT IVORY (2023 – NR) 1 hr. 52 min. Documentary. Follows the history of the Merchant Ivory partnership, featuring interviews with James Ivory and close collaborators detailing and celebrating their experiences of being a part of the company.

MISERY (1990 – R) 1 hr. 47 min. Psychological Drama. After a famous author is rescued from a car crash by a fan of his novels, he comes to realize that the care he is receiving is only the beginning of a nightmare of captivity and abuse.

A REAL PAIN (2024 – R) 1 hr. 30 min. Comedy/Drama. Mismatched cousins reunite for a tour through Poland to honor their beloved grandmother, but their old tensions resurface against the backdrop of their family history.

SMALL THINGS LIKE THESE (2024 - PG-13) 1 hr. 38 min. Drama. In 1985 devoted father Bill Furlong discovers disturbing secrets kept by the local convent and uncovers shocking truths of his own.

STAR TREK: THE MOTION PICTURE (1979 – G) 2hrs. 23 min. Sci-Fi. When an alien spacecraft of enormous power is spotted approaching Earth, Admiral James T. Kirk resumes command of the overhauled USS Enterprise in order to intercept it.

STAR TREK II: THE WRATH OF KHAN (1982 – PG) 1 hr. 53 min. Sci-Fi. With the assistance of the Enterprise crew, Admiral Kirk must stop an old nemesis, Khan Noonien Singh, from using the life-generating Genesis Device as the ultimate weapon.

THE THING (1982 – R) 1 hr. 49 min. Alien Invasion/Horror. A research team in Antarctica is hunted by a shape-shifting alien that assumes the appearance of its victims.
