

U.S. theatres generally delay the broadcasts until the evening, or show the production on different days. These are the original live satellite feeds; no editing takes place between the time of transmission and showing.

SYNOPSES OF UPCOMING FILMS

CANDYMAN (1992 – R) 1 hr. 39 min. Horror. The Candyman, a murderous soul with a hook for a hand, is accidentally summoned to reality by a skeptic grad student researching the monster's myth.

CARMEN JONES (1954 – NR) 1 hr. 45 min. Musical/Drama. At an all-Black army camp, civilian parachute maker and "hot bundle" Carmen Jones is desired by many of the men. Naturally, she wants Joe, who's engaged to sweet Cindy Lou and about to go into pilot training for the Korean War. Going after him, she succeeds only in getting him into the stockade. While she awaits his release, trouble looms for both of them. Songs from the Bizet opera with modernized lyrics.

A COMPLETE UNKNOWN (2024 – R) 2 hrs. 21 min. Drama/Music. In 1961, an unknown 19-year-old Bob Dylan arrives in New York City with his guitar and forges relationships with music icons on his meteoric rise, culminating in a groundbreaking performance that reverberates worldwide.

FROZEN II (2019 – PG) 1 hr. 43 min. Animation/Family. Anna, Elsa, Kristoff, Olaf and Sven leave Arendelle to travel to an ancient, autumn-bound forest of an enchanted land. They set out to find the origin of Elsa's powers in order to save their kingdom.

GODZILLA (1954 – NR) 1 hr. 36 min. Monster Horror. After a dinosaur-like beast - awoken from undersea hibernation by atom bomb testing - ravages Tokyo, a scientist must decide if his similarly dangerous weapon should be used to destroy it. *Shown in Japanese with English subtitles*.

GROUNDHOG DAY (1993 – PG) 1 hr. 41 min. Romantic Comedy. A narcissistic, self-centered weatherman finds himself in a time loop on Groundhog Day.

THE IMPORTANCE OF BEING (2024 – PG-13) 3 hrs. Comedy. While assuming the role of a dutiful guardian in the country, Jack lets loose in town under a false identity. Meanwhile, his friend Algy adopts a similar facade. Hoping to impress two eligible ladies, the gentlemen find themselves caught in a web of lies they must carefully navigate.

NICKEL BOYS (2024 – PG-13) 2 hrs. 20 min. Drama. Based on the Pulitzer Prize-winning novel by Colson Whitehead, "Nickel Boys" chronicles the powerful friendship between two young African-American men navigating the harrowing trials of reform school together in Florida.

NOSFERATU (2024 – R) 2 hrs. 12 min. Horror/Fantasy. A gothic tale of obsession between a haunted young woman and the terrifying vampire infatuated with her, causing untold horror in its wake.

PRETTY WOMAN (1991 – R) 1 hr. 59 min. Comedy/Romance. Edward, a rich entrepreneur, hires Vivian, a prostitute, to accompany him to a few social events. Trouble ensues when he falls in love with her and they try to bridge the gap between their worlds.

SING SING (2023 – R) 1hr. 47 min. Drama. Divine G, imprisoned at Sing Sing for a crime he didn't commit, finds purpose by acting in a theatre group alongside other incarcerated men in this story of resilience, humanity, and the transformative power of art.

WICKED (2024 – PG) 2 hrs. 40 min. Fairy Tale/Musical. Elphaba, a misunderstood young woman because of her green skin, and Galinda, a popular girl, become friends at Shiz University in the Land of Oz. After an encounter with the Wonderful Wizard of Oz, their friendship reaches a crossroads.
